♦ PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The guidelines detailed within this operational framework govern the collaborative paramedical and allied healthcare programs offered jointly by **Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (BFUHS)**, Faridkot, Punjab, and the **Indian Medical Association (IMA)** Headquarters, New Delhi. These regulations are universally applicable across all IMA-recognized study centers administering these certified courses.

ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Certificate / Diploma Courses

Candidates seeking admission must satisfy at least one of the following eligibility brackets:

- ➔ Passed 10+2 in any stream with a minimum of **60% marks**.
- ➔ Holds a valid **ANM / GNM** professional qualification.
- ➔ Holds a **Graduation degree** in any educational stream.

Long-Term / Short-Term Training Courses

(Skill Refinement Frameworks)

- ➔ Identical eligibility requirements apply: 10+2 in any stream with a minimum of 60% marks, ANM / GNM certification, or a full Graduation in any stream.

TUITION FEE STRUCTURE

Prescribed Student Fees:

₹ 50,000/- Per Semester

Standardized terminal tuition fee for courses organized in shared collaboration with BFUHS and IMA.

EXAMINATION SCHEME

Final examinations are strictly coordinated between the IMA and BBUHS executives to preserve structural transparency, fairness, absolute confidentiality, and complete operational efficiency throughout.

CERTIFICATION & SIGNATURES

- ➔ **Issuing Protocol:** Diploma, Fellowship, and Certificate credentials shall be formally issued through BBUHS, Faridkot, featuring official institutional logos of both partner organizations.
- ➔ **Joint Endorsement:** Competent authorities of both IMA and BBUHS will jointly execute mark sheets and final certificates. These documents carry verified names and corporate insignias.

INSTITUTE AFFILIATION FRAMEWORK

Applicable parameters guiding freshly accredited study center validation procedures:

Application Processing Fee

- ➔ **Processing Fee (Non-Refundable):** ₹ 10,000/- for each individual course.
- ➔ **Institutional Break-up:** (5,000/- retained by BBUHS and 5,000/- retained by IMA).



AFFILIATION FEE SCHEDULE

Inspection & Accreditation

- → **Team Travel Logistics:** Travel and Daily Allowance (TA/DA) for the appointed inspection panels must be directly borne by the applicant institute.
- → **Accreditation Mapping:** Guidelines currently structured by IMA will continue to run, subject to modification or elaboration by BFUHS in consultative feedback loops with IMA.



CREDIT TRANSFER POLICY

For candidates enrolled at any IMA recognized centre outside Punjab, the candidate, with credit transfer policy, shall undertake a part of the course at a recognized centre in Punjab (accredited by BFUHS and IMA) through IMA HQs, IMA Punjab when authorized by IMA HQs., and finally will undergo assessment/exam conducted by the committee constituted jointly or severally as agreed upon by BFUHS and IMA.

Note: The above operational terms and criteria are subject to periodic modification by mutual administrative agreement of BFUHS and IMA.
