

Greetings from the Indian Medical Association!

First of all, I would like to bring to the notice of all members of IMA that the recent directive from the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of Indian Medical Association & Anr. Vs. Unioin of India & Ors. Writ Petition (C) No. 645 / 2022 (Re: Misleading / disparaging advertisement

by Patanjali Ayurved Ltd.) stands as a pivotal step in ensuring integrity in medical advertisements and combatting misinformation. In response to the Indian Medical Association's concerns, the court has mandated that Patanjali Ayurved cease disseminating misleading claims and advertisements that undermine modern systems of medicine. The bench, led by Justice Amanullah, underscored the seriousness of such infractions, indicating potential fines of up to Rs 1 crore for products making false claims regarding disease cures. Emphasizing the need for responsible communication, the court has instructed Patanjali to halt such misleading advertisements immediately and refrain from making casual statements to the media. This landmark decision aims not to pit Ayurveda against allopathy but rather seeks to address the pervasive issue of deceptive medical advertising. Additionally, consultations are underway with the Union Government to devise practical recommendations to tackle this issue effectively. The Indian Medical Association expresses its profound gratitude to the Hon'ble supreme court for upholding ethical standards in healthcare communication, safeguarding the public from misleading information. This momentous ruling, applauded by the Indian Medical Association, reaffirms the importance of ethical practices in the promotion of healthcare products and treatments.



IMA fights back

In a legal petition filed by IMA Hqs, Hon Supreme Court came heavily on Ramdev's Patanjali saying Rs one crore penalty will be levied per product if the outfit continues to advertise false claims of cure. Justice Ahsanuddin Amanullah and Prashant Kumar Mishra issued stern warning to the company of Baba Ramdev.

"All such false and misleading advertisements of Patanjali Ayurved have to stop immediately. The Court will take any such infraction very seriously, and the Court will also consider imposing costs to the extent of Rs. 1 crore on every product regarding which a false claim is made that it can "cure" a particular disease," Justice Amanullah orally said.
