From the pen of National President, IMA



My Dear Seniors and Colleagues,

May your Dussehra be victorious and your Diwali shine with prosperity and joy!

I am pleased to report that our "Aao Gaon Chalen" project is progressing successfully. IMA HQs is sincerely grateful to our Branches for their unwavering support in this transformative initiative. So far, we have adopted almost 1145 villages, and I would like to once again request each and every one of you to consider adopting at least one village within your jurisdiction.

I am pleased to inform you that I attended the High-Level Meeting on "Swasthya Chintan Shivir" conducted by the Union Health Minister for Health & Family Welfare in Dehradun, Uttarakhand in the month of July where all the Health Ministers and Secretaries from states participated and spoke on several health related issues in their respective states. I had been invited to speak especially on National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme; Immunisation System in India; Medical Nursing and Allied Health Education; National Transplant Programme and District Residency Programme. During the meeting I stressed the surgery may be allowed only at CHC or above level. I cautioned against the involvement of "Quacks" in the Healthcare Sector. I also informed the house that IMA has launched Aao Gaon Chalen project through our 1700+ branches across the country. These branches have been advised to adopt at least one village for health services. This initiative may also be shared with CMO/DMs for their active involvement I appealed for synchronised coordinated work among IMA, Government, NGO for optimum output in Healthcare sector.

Further, I emphasised the need to increase the notification of TB Patients at the community level particularly those who have not completed their treatment plant. I also emphasised that atleast one nursing college should be opened at district level for the huge attrition rate of nursing students due to the quality of nursing education and number of nursing colleges in India.

We extend our heartfelt appreciation to the Hon'ble Health Minister, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya Ji, for his swift and active response to IMA's requests. His intervention has led to the suspension of NMC's new guidelines on Generic Medicine and Sponsored CMEs, and he has also accepted IMA's advice to reduce the NEET PG cut-off to 30 percentiles.

On the 28th of September 2023, I had an engaging discussion at the "National Conclave of Medical Educators and the LAUNCH of the Association of Medical Educators of India," hosted by the Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences (Deemed to be University), Nagpur, Maharashtra.

On 30th September, I inaugurated the New IMA Blood Bank Block of IMA Kanpur Branch on the Eve of "National Blood Donation Day" and the team of Kanpur IMA Branch was emphasised to Donate Blood and percolate the information to others.

In the month of October, we have commenced work on the reconstruction of the new IMA Building, which involves the demolition of the existing structure. This redevelopment is aimed at having the new Multistorey Modernized IMA Building ready by 2028. This will enable us to celebrate the centenary year function in 2028 in this state-of-the-art facility. We are currently in discussions with NBCC and various other relevant authorities to ensure the success of this project.

From the 2nd of October to the 7th of October, I, as a Council Member of WMA, along with the Honorary Secretary General, participated in a high-level meeting and engaged in discussions with leaders from various countries across the world during the World Medical Association's General Assembly Meeting held in Kigali, Rwanda. In these interactive sessions, we shared thoughts and ideas to enhance the global Healthcare Ecosystem. We also discussed the state of Primary Healthcare in India for its betterment.

During the WMA General Assembly Meeting, we attended the CMAAO Luncheon Meeting, where we discussed topics related to immunization and various other health-related issues.



On the 15th of October, I had the privilege of attending the 2nd State Level Refresher Course & CME Programme hosted by IMA Lucknow. Eminent speakers and renowned medical practitioners shared insights on various vital healthcare topics. I inaugurated the State-of-the-Art Blood Bank and Comfortable Guest House in IMA Lucknow Branch. Furthermore, I also attended the Installation Ceremony of IMA-HBI Lucknow Unit.

On intervention of IMA, General Insurance Council (GI Council) on behalf of the insurance industry hold a meeting in Mumbai on 18th October 2023 and took the initiative to expand the Cashless Treatment Facilities to all insured patients. This meeting was attended by me along with Dr. R V Asokan, National President (Elect) and Dr. A K Ravikumar, Chairman, IMA-HBI where we have raised issues regarding problems being faced by doctors and asked them to create a single window contact to meet out the various issues of our doctors and unilateral deduction should not be done by GI Council. Payment should be taken on the agreed terms. It was further emphasised that hospital should be categorised in accordance with the treatment facilities of doctors. GI Council requested IMA to participate in the activities of the council in more & more numbers. The industry seeks the cooperation of hospitals in facilitating insured individuals to access this cashless facility. The GI Council aims to engage in discussions with the Provider Community to understand and address any concerns they may have in this regard. They have requested IMA to actively participate in this initiative.

From 26th to 28th October 2023 I have attended Annual IMA-AMS National Conference (AMSCON-2023) at Kozhikode (Calicut), Kerala for Inaugural Function and the prestigious Convocation Ceremony as the Chief Guest.

Dr. Ricardo, President, World Federation for Medical Education accompanied by his wife Dr. Maria Elena, Dr. Russell D'Souza Dr. Russell Franco D'Souza Head and Chair Department of Education International Program International Chair in Bioethics, Melbourne Australia, and Dr. Vedprakash Mishra, Pro-Chancellor, DattaMeghe Institute of Higher Education & Research (Deemed to be University), Nagpur visited IMA headquarters today dated 26th September, 2023.

In an wide ranging interactive discussion with the National office bearers of IMA led by its President Dr. Sharad Kumar Agrawal in the presence of Honorary Secretary General Dr. Anilkumar J. Nayak, Dr. Shitij Bali, HFS and Past President, IMA Dr. Vinay Aggarwal. Dr. Ricardo recorded his sincere appreciation for the immaculate work being dispensed by IMA in the interest of the medical profession as well as medical education in a consistent manner with immaculate zeal and commitment.

Dr. Sharad Agrawal profusely thanked World Federation for Medical Education led by Dr. Ricardo for granting recognition to the National Medical Commission, New Delhi, as a result of which, 706 medical colleges geographically located in India stand accredited by the World Federation for Medical Education and thereby would get included in the Directory of Medical Colleges of World Health Organization. This recognition is for a period of 10 years prospectively and every new medical college that shall be created in India during the said period would be taken as accredited by the World Federation for Medical Education and resultantly would find entry in the said Directory of Medical Schools.

National President, IMA Dr. Sharad Kumar Agarwal elaborated that this achievement was exclusively possible because of the astute visionary stewardship of our dynamic leader Dr. Ketan Desai the Former National President of IMA, Medical Council of India and World Medical Association, who vested the responsibility of structuring the competency based medical education model to the Academic Council of the then Medical Council of India under the Chairmanship of Dr. Vedprakash Mishra which not only structured the said model in terms of the guidelines prescribed by the World Federation for Medical Education but also evolved AETCOM (Attitude, Ethics and Communication Model) incorporated in the curriculum which made it at par with international standards. The contribution of Dr. Russell D'Souza in shaping the AETCOM Module with Dr. Mishra was also appreciated.

It is the launch of said competency based undergraduate medical education model incorporating AETCOM Model therein from academic session 2019-20 across India whereby the 1st CBME batch of Medical Graduates would come out in November, 2023 upon clearing their final MBBS Examination that the recognition of World Federation for Medical Education stands accorded.

Vemuri S Murthy, MD

Dr. Vemuri S Murthy is an Alumnus of Guntur Medical College, Andhra Pradesh, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, India (General Surgery) and Rush University, Chicago, USA (Anesthesiology). A US Anesthesiologist for over three decades, he is currently an adjunct Faculty in Emergency Medicine @ the University of Illinois College Medicine, Chicago, involved with Indo-US Resuscitation Projects.

Hailed as a "Pioneer of Resuscitation Medicine in India," Dr. Murthy initiated mandatory resuscitation curriculum model at NTR University of Health Sciences in Andhra Pradesh in 2012. He is affiliated with the American Heart Association (AHA) for more than three decades having served in various capacities such as a member of the AHA International Committee, National and International teaching faculty. He is the Founder (2012) of the Chicago Medical Society's community CPR project, "Saving More Illinois Lives through Education" (SMILE) and authored Indo-US multi-lingual community CPR educational materials endorsed by the Chicago Indian Consulate.

Dr. Murthy is a Visiting Professor to Indian Medical Institutes such as All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS, Mangalagiri), chaired International Resuscitation Conferences and has published Resuscitation articles and book chapters. His Indo-US collaborated research work includes a ground-breaking "Cardiac Arrest Registry". He is the Honorary Advisor to the Odisha State Government (Health and Family Welfare) guiding statewide CPR projects.

Dr. Murthy, a past President of the Chicago Medical Society and Indian American Medical Association (Illinois) is the recipient of several prestigious national and international awards including a Medal of US Congress and two Lifetime Achievement Awards in recognition of his Indo-US contributions to Teaching, Training and Research in Cardiac Resuscitation and Community Heart Health Awareness Projects.
